Glendale Police Identify Pedestrian in Fatal Collision

GLENDALE, AZ. – On Tuesday, October 29, 2019, at approximately 5:49 PM, Glendale Police responded to reports of a pedestrian that was struck by a vehicle while in the roadway near 55th Ave and Camelback Rd. As officers arrived, an adult male pedestrian was located and had sustained life-threatening injuries. First responders administered emergency life-saving first aid and transported the victim to a local valley hospital. The driver involved remained on scene following the incident.

The pedestrian later succumbed to his injuries from the collision. He was identified as 65-year-old Glendale resident, Ha Hoang Trang.

Detectives from the Vehicular Crimes Unit assumed the investigation and were able to determine the vehicle had been traveling westbound when it struck Trang who was crossing Camelback Road. It does not appear speed or impairment were factors of the collision. The investigation is ongoing at this time. The driver has not been charged criminally.
