Legislative Link Update

March 25, 2020

Hello and welcome to the 2020 Glendale Legislative Link Program.

On Monday, the Arizona Legislature passed a FY 2021 "skinny" budget and has adjourned until April 13th. The budget will be transmitted to the Governor who is expected to sign it. The adjournment motion also contained a clause that would allow the Speaker and President to call the bodies back with a 24-hour notice if it is determined to be necessary. If/when the Legislature returns to the floor this session, all one-time budget appropriations approved through House or Senate bills will be included in a supplemental Budget Reconciliation Bill (BRB) that is expected to be introduced when leadership has determined that the Legislature is ready to adjourn Sine Die for the 2020 Legislation Session.

Arizona Together Initiative, Linking Arizonans To Resources During COVID-19 Outbreak

Governor Ducey has launched the Arizona Together initiative to support Arizonans during the COVID-19 outbreak, connecting individuals and businesses to resources, raising money for community organizations and providing information on volunteer opportunities. The website provides a wide range of resources including how to receive financial assistance, food, and healthcare. Also included on the webpage are business resources, information for homeowners experiencing financial hardship directly or indirectly related to Coronavirus and how to seek help with utility payments and internet access. As part of this initiative, Governor Ducey has also created the AZ Coronavirus Relief Fund. The fund will provide financial support to organizations working to mitigate the impacts of COVID-19 in Arizona. Initially, the fund will focus on the following immediate needs:

- Funding of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) for frontline medical personnel.
- Supporting non-profit organizations that help vulnerable Arizonans through food banks, homeless shelters, domestic violence facilities and other services.
- Expanding technology access for low-income students to help them transition to online learning.
