As engaged members of the community we wanted to remind you about the importance of completing the 2020 Census. Not only do census numbers impact how billions of federal dollars are allocated each year, but they also determine electoral districts for local, state, and federal offices as well as the number of seats Arizona receives in the US House of Representatives.

Due to COVID-19, the deadline to respond to the 2020 Census has been extended. Census Bureau employees will begin going door-to-door to follow up with households that have not yet responded in mid-August. Luckily it has never been easier to respond to the census on your own, without the need to interact with a census taker face-to-face. Responding to the 2020 Census will take less than 10 minutes and can be completed online or by phone. Each resident counted represents approximately \$3,000 yearly in state, federal, and regional funds that support critical services in our community including public safety, education, healthcare, transportation, housing, parks, libraries, and senior services. These programs are more important than ever as our community works to recover from this public health and economic crisis. Make sure our community receives the resources we need to support businesses and residents.
