## Glendale Police Seek Assistance in Locating Homicide Suspect

**GLENDALE, AZ.** – On January 21, 2021 just after 12:30PM, Glendale Police responded to a report of an unknown trouble call for service near 5600 N. 62<sup>nd</sup> Ave. Officers arrived on scene and located an adult female victim inside the residence with multiple stab wounds. She was transported to a local valley hospital and was later pronounced deceased.

The investigation revealed that the victim identified as 29-year-old Marissa Canedo-Gonzalez had been inside the residence when an argument ensued between her and 31-year-old Arnulfo Rivera-Jimenez (fiancé). Witnesses reported that he stabbed her multiple times and then fled the residence. Homicide detectives took over the investigation which is ongoing at this time.

Detectives are seeking the public's help in locating Arnulfo Rivera-Jimenez. He was last seen in the area of 51<sup>st</sup> Ave and Thomas driving a 2000 white Chevy Silverado extended cab truck displaying AZ license plate APG2311. Rivera-Jimenez is described as approximately 5'8" tall and 200 pounds. He is believed to have fled to Mexico.
