

## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

The City of Glendale is seeking public comment on proposed changes to its Public Housing Authority 2023 Annual PHA Plan and 2023-2027 Capital Fund Plan (CFP).

The Public Comment Period begins on February 10, 2023 and ends on March 26, 2023.

Public hearings regarding the plan will be held during the Community Development Advisory Committee (CDAC) meeting on March 16, 2023, beginning at 6:30 pm. See Procedures for Public Participation at the end of this notice.

The Agency Annual Plan includes the Housing Choice Voucher Administrative Plan (Admin Plan) and the Admissions and Continued Occupancy Plan (ACOP). Memo of changes to the Admin Plan and the ACOP will be posted on the website.

The Glendale Housing Authority (GHA) has published the notice for accepting the Project Based Voucher (PBV) developer proposals. GHA intends to commit up to 20% of its Housing Choice Vouchers to be utilized as Project Based Vouchers to attract new development of quality affordable housing to Glendale. The Glendale Housing Authority intends to award Project Based Vouchers in conjunction with State of Arizona Low Income Housing Tax Credit competitive awards, Maricopa County competitive awards, or through conducting a request for proposals.

The Capital Fund Program (CFP) is a HUD sponsored program for housing agencies to perform capital improvements to Public Housing units. GHA will focus its CFP on replacing outdated HVAC units, roof repair and replacement and exterior painting.
