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- 1. The City of Glendale's Transportation Department, regulates Block Parties. Call the Transportation Department at (623) 930-2940 to request authorized forms and information.
- 2. Completed forms must be returned to the Transportation Department ten (10) working days before the Block Party's date.
- 3. Ninety-percent of every household on the street with the Block Party request must sign the Neighborhood Authorization Form. Signatories should be 18 years or older. Only resident homeowners, 18 years or older, can apply for an application. The applicant <u>MUST</u> be a resident of the street to be blocked off and <u>MUST</u> be in attendance at all times during the Block Party. All applicants **MUST** state the purpose of the Block Party.
- 4. All closures must start and end at an intersection or a dead-end street. Mid-block street closures and street closures that are adjacent to arterial roads (i.e. 51st Ave. Peoria Ave.) are not permitted. Block parties are restricted to residential neighborhoods and will be allowed only on those streets approved by the Transportation Department.
- 5. No alterations of any kind may be made to the street or sidewalks. The user shall remove any debris on the public right-of-way immediately following the activity. The City of Glendale will levy a charge for cleanup or repairs as a result of the Block Party and hold the applicant liable.
- 6. The Block Party shall conclude no later than 10:00 p.m. in compliance with the city noise ordinance # 1567 Article IV Section 26-66 (b).
- 7. Barricades for closing the roadway shall be placed and removed at times designated by the Block Party Closure Standards. **NO** parked vehicles or any other method of street closures other than the city provided barricades are permitted.
- 8. Barricades will be supplied by the City of Glendale and dropped off at the applicant's address twenty-four (24) hours prior to the start of the Block Party. The city will collect the barricades at the same address within two working days following the Block Party.
- 9. For safety purposes, the Transportation or the Police Department may require those organizing the party to hire police officers to direct and control traffic adjacent to the closed portion of the roadway.
- 10. Permission to close the street does not allow for any violations of State or Local laws.
- 11. Block Party applications will **NOT** be authorized until the Transportation Department approves the application and that the application is in concurrence with the Police and Fire Departments.
