A Unique Opportunity to Celebrate Life

The City of Glendale's Parks & Recreation Division offers you a very unique and thoughtful way to celebrate life and love while making an extremely meaningful contribution to your community.

Through the city's Dedicate a Tree program, you have the opportunity to give a rare gift—a living gift that can be enjoyed for years to come.

This program enables you to have a 24-inch box tree planted in a Glendale city park to celebrate special occasions such as births, weddings, birthdays, anniversaries or graduations. Watch the tree grow along with the child or union to which it is dedicated. Or commemorate the loss of a loved one or dear friend by planting a living memorial that could last for years.

Civic and youth groups, sports teams or churches can use the Dedicate a Tree program to honor individuals or groups for special achievements or leadership. This is a wonderful way for your group to display pride in the community.

How You Can Participate

All you have to do to participate in this program is complete the form, make a donation of \$400, recommend a city park for the tree's home and select the type of tree you would like planted (see tree listing). Trees are planted October through April to afford them the best opportunity to thrive and are guaranteed for one year. Only 24-inch box trees are used, as they have a better survivability rate. The Parks & Recreation Division reserves the right to select an alternate park site or tree type to ensure compatibility with the parks master plan and low water-use guidelines.

Once we have received your application form and donation, you will be contacted to make arrangements for the date, time and location of the tree planting so that you may be present and will know exactly where the tree is growing. You will also receive a commemorative 8 x 10" plaque, inscribed according to your wishes as a keepsake or to give as a gift. Please note that the placement of permanent markers or plaques with the tree is not permitted.
